Each year the club has 6 competitions and usually they are all open competitions, which means that there is no subject or theme to be observed. In some years, one of the competitions has had a theme such as shadows, reflections or architecture.

This year there has been an increase of members in the B Class. This is a class for members who are honing their skills or are new to the club. LCC is very proud at the rapid advancement of members who start out in this class. Because at each competition, the judge critiques the images, members learn quickly how to improve and take better photographs. They learn how to eliminate distracting elements and how to improve the composition of a photograph. A visit to one of our competitions is beneficial to anyone who seriously wants to improve his or her skills.

The judge for this competition is Jerry Fornaratto who is a first place winner of the PSA (Photographic Society of America) International Wildlife Image of the Year 2008. He is a nine-time winner of PSA's "Best in Show" award in various international competitions. He is also an eight-time winner of NJFCC (New Jersey Federation of Camera Clubs) first place medal. Jerry is very active in photographic circles as PSA region 14 Director (NY and NJ) and member of two camera clubs where he holds office as president or has held that office.
